


using brush #60 for perfect blush and bronzer application




Using your #60 ultimate blush/ bronzer brush, apply your matte bronzer, beginning at the back of your cheekbone. Sweep it forward toward the apple of your cheek, then take the brush back toward your ear. This lays your color in place.

Now take your brush and use it in the opposite direction (up and down) to blend. Be sure to blend well, or it won't look natural.



Don't forget to add a little at the temples to help shape your face. Sweep the bronzing powder up around the temples and eye sockets. This always gives the face more color and gives you a glow.



Feel free to blend some bronzer along your jawbone. This also helps create that glow and define your face.






using brush #64 and #60 for prefect creme blush application

Here is the secret to a perfectly flushed cheek. You are going to achieve this by layering your blush, starting with a great crème

blush. Using your #64 crème blush brush (because I always think it is easier to

apply creme blush with a brush, thus why I created this brush), apply your crème blush to the apples of the cheeks, starting at the front of your apple and working towards the back.

Follow with a light dusting of loose or pressed powder.



Now to reinforce that flush, smile and apply your powder blush with your new #60 ultimate blush/ bronzer brush on the apple of your cheek, starting at the front of your apple and working towards the back.
